## Purpose of the Advisory Board

The Office of Student Conflict Resolution (OSCR) Student Advisory Board provides an opportunity for University of Michigan students to advise, interact, and engage with University staff and volunteers responsible for facilitating conflict resolution within the student population. The Board also provides a unique opportunity to learn the processes that OSCR utilizes in managing conflict, including conflict coaching, facilitated dialogue, and mediation. The recommendations made by this Advisory Board help OSCR on its mission of building trust, promoting justice, and teaching peace.

## Objectives

U-M students involved with the Office of Student Conflict Resolution Student Advisory Board will:

- Attend monthly meetings where they provide advice and make recommendations about the various programs and services that OSCR offers.
- Engage with a diverse group of undergraduate and graduate students in topics relating to conflict resolutions, while building a community of OSCR advocates and ambassadors.
- Learn the function and mission of the Office of Student Conflict Resolution.
